IONITY High Power Chargers back on line

Munich (January 29) – In response to an urgent recommendation by HUBER+SUHNER, a supplier of high-power charging cable technology, IONITY shut down a number of its high-powered chargers on January 25th as a precautionary measure. This was a result of a short circuit occurring in a first-generation prototype plug at a test site.

In the meantime, an intensive investigation and subsequent testing in conjunction with partners and suppliers have confirmed that the system meets both the required functionality and safety standards.

IONITY thanks its partners for their rapid and professional response thus enabling those 20 IONITY charging stations affected by this measure in Austria, Switzerland, France, Belgium and Denmark (except for Aabenraa) to resume normal service.
